## TRINITY TRUST TEAM - OVERVIEW

The Trinity Trust Team was established in 2000 by the Churches Together in Godalming, a body of churches with the vision to support Christian youth ministry within the churches and outreach into local schools and community. Today it remains funded largely by churches in the town, from individual donors and external (non-faith based) funding organisations.

TTT comprises a team director and three full time youth workers whose youth provision varies from overtly Christian ministry (church based work/bible study, discipleship groups, faith based school assemblies and lunchtime Christian Unions) to community outreach; witnessing to young people through after school cafés/drop-ins and a raft of youth groups and activities. TTT also relies on a team of volunteer leaders who help out at many of the groups throughout the week.

TTT also supports local schools through various programmes and workshops ranging from transitioning from junior to senior school, Yr 7 induction, lunchtime and after school clubs.

The Trinity Trust Team pursues a united and growing vision for God's work with young people; to work together to **witness**, to **nurture** in faith and **mentor** young people throughout the Godalming area.

### WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT:

#### **To lead only when you are available/willing**

We work our rotas around when people are available. If you want to lead every week, that'd great, but if you want to lead once a term that is OK too! If you want to take a term off, again that is fine – just let us know when you can/can't be there!

#### **To be given opportunities for further training**
